Care Instructions and Limited Warranty

Care Instructions

Maintaining the good looks of your powder coated products is just like caring for your car and is a smart way to protect your investment. Over time, with exposure to the elements, powder coatings may show signs of weathering such as loss of gloss, chalking and slight color change. A simple regular clean will minimize the effects of weathering and will remove dirt, grime and other build-up detrimental to all powder coatings.

The frequency of cleaning depends in part on the standard of appearance that is required and also the requirement to remove deposits that could, during prolonged contact with either the powder film or the metal substrate (if exposed), cause damage.

Sheltered areas can be more at risk of coating degradation than exposed areas. This is because wind-blown salt and other pollutants may adhere to the surface and will not be cleaned away with rainfall. These areas should be inspected and cleaned if necessary yearly with documentation of such inspections and cleanings being faxed to our office at 972-488-0636 for the limited warranty to remain in effect.

Once applied, the film must be washed at least every twelve (12) months with a solution of a mild liquid detergent and water using a soft brush, followed by a fresh water rinse, to remove all debris and contaminants. Please refer to AAMA for precise instructions.

Solvent-based and abrasive cleaners should not be used on the film. These cleaners are likely to result in chemical attack on the film and will void the limited warranty set forth below.

We require that proof of inspections and cleanings be documented, signed, dated and then faxed to our office at 972-488-0636 every (12) months on all coating areas warranted each and every (12) months for the entirety of the (10) TEN year period or this warranty will be considered void.

WARNING! Do not under any circumstances use strong solvents such as thinners or solutions containing chlorinated hydrocarbons, esters or ketones. Abrasive cleaners or cutting compounds should not be used. This limited warranty will not cover damage caused by chemicals or improper use or installation of our product.
